### **Incumbents/priests-in-charge**

(I drew this to the attention of the Diocesan Parsonages Board Secretary when asking for confirmation of the accuracy of the clauses relating to parsonage houses.)

## PASTORAL SCHEME

This Scheme is made by the Church Commissioners ("the Commissioners") this 20<sup>th</sup> day of January 2010 in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1983, the Right Reverend Timothy, Bishop of Leicester, having consented thereto.

### WHEREAS

1. by virtue of a Scheme made by the Commissioners in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1983 on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of July 1989 ("the 1989 Scheme") it was provided that a team ministry should be established for the area of the benefice of Holy Trinity, Hinckley;
2. the said Bishop has submitted proposals to the Commissioners for, inter alia, the termination of the said team ministry.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby provided as follows:-

### Termination of Team Ministry

1. (1) The team ministry established by the 1989 Scheme shall hereby be terminated and the office of vicar established by clause 1(2) of the said Scheme shall be abolished.  
(2) The benefice of Holy Trinity, Hinckley shall be a rectory and the office of incumbent shall be restored to the status of a freehold office.  
(3) The patronage of the said benefice shall be vested in the Leicester Diocesan Board of Patronage.

### Creation of new benefice and parish

2. A new benefice which shall be named "The Benefice of Saint John, Hinckley" shall be created in the diocese of Leicester, and the area of the new benefice, which shall constitute a new parish and be named "The Parish of Saint John, Hinckley", shall be all that part of the parish of Holy Trinity, Hinckley which is shown stippled and lettered " A " on the annexed map.

### Parish church

3. If upon the date on which this Scheme comes into operation the church of Saint John the Evangelist within the area of the new parish has been approved by the Bishop, after consultation with the Leicester Diocesan Advisory Committee and the Leicester Diocesan Mission and Pastoral Committee, as suitable to be a parish church and has been consecrated, it shall be the parish church of the new parish; but if upon that date it has been neither so approved nor consecrated it shall become the parish church as from the date upon which it shall have been both approved and consecrated.

**Archdeaconry and deanery**

4. The new benefice and its constituent parish shall belong to the archdeaconry of Loughborough and the deanery of Sparkenhoe West.

**Designation of first incumbent**

5. If immediately before this Scheme comes into operation the Reverend Gary James Weston is licensed by the Bishop to serve within the area of the benefice of Holy Trinity, Hinckley, he shall be the first incumbent of the new benefice.

**Place of residence**

6. The house and premises known as Saint John's Vicarage, 7 Rosemary Way, Hinckley, LE10 0LN (situated on glebe land of the diocese of Leicester), together with the site and appurtenances thereof and the grounds usually occupied and enjoyed therewith, shall without any conveyance or other assurance be transferred from the Leicester Diocesan Board of Finance to the incumbent of the new benefice in his corporate capacity as his official residence.

**Patronage**

7. Subject to clause 5 hereof, the patronage of the new benefice shall be vested in the Leicester Diocesan Board of Patronage.

**Coming into effect of this Scheme**

8. This Scheme shall come into operation upon the first day of the month following the date of it being made by the Commissioners.

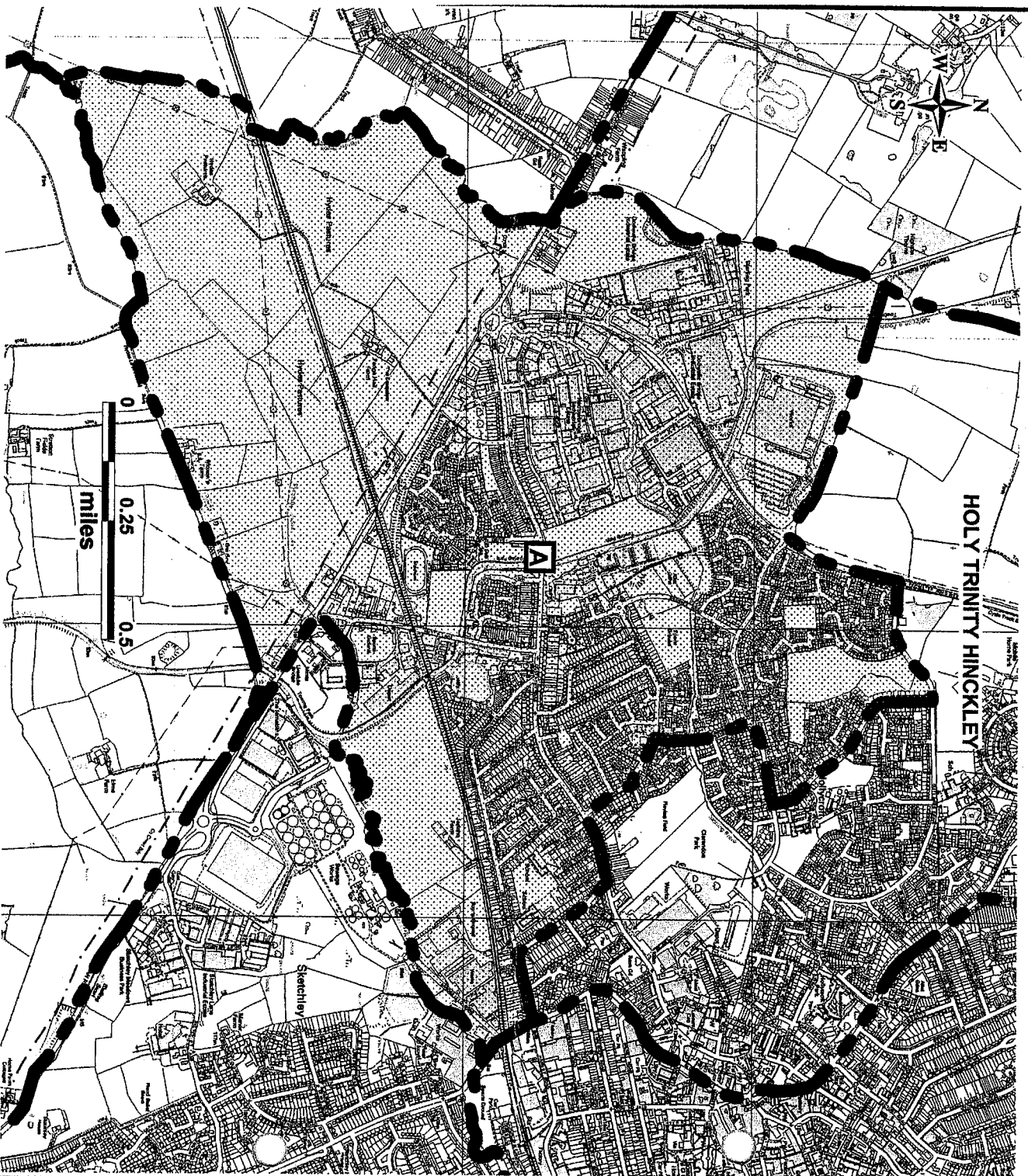
