PASTORAL SCHEME

This Scheme is made by the Church Commissioners this 29th day of April 2010 in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1983, the Right Reverend Timothy, Bishop of Leicester, having consented thereto.

Alteration of areas of parishes

1. The areas of the parishes of Barlestone; Nailstone; Newbold de Verdun; Market Bosworth, Cadeby with Sutton Cheney and Congerstone; Thornton, Bagworth and Stanton under Bardon; and Kirkby Mallory shall be altered in the manner described in the Schedule to this Scheme and delineated on the annexed maps A and B.

Union of benefices

2. The benefice of Newbold de Verdun and Kirkby Mallory and the benefice of Barlestone in the diocese of Leicester shall be united to create a new benefice which shall be named "The Benefice of Newbold de Verdun, Barlestone and Kirkby Mallory", and the area of the new benefice shall, subject to clause 1 hereof, comprise the parish of Newbold de Verdun; the parish of Kirkby Mallory; and the parish of Barlestone, which parishes shall continue distinct.

Archdeaconry and deanery

3. The new benefice and its constituent parishes shall belong to the archdeaconry of Loughborough and the deanery of Sparkenhoe West.

Designation of first incumbent

4. If immediately before this Scheme comes into operation the Reverend Thomas Henry Corfe Meyrick is licensed by the Bishop to serve within the area of either of the benefices referred to in clause 2. hereof, he shall be the first incumbent of the new benefice.

Place of residence

5. The parsonage house of the benefice of Newbold de Verdun and Kirkby Mallory shall be the place of residence of the incumbent of the new benefice.

Disposal of parsonage

6. The parsonage house of the benefice of Barlestone shall be transferred to the Leicester Diocesan Board of Finance for diocesan purposes.

Patronage

7. Subject to clause 4 hereof, the right of presentation to the new benefice shall on each occasion be exercised jointly by the Bishop of Leicester in his corporate capacity and the President, Fellows and Scholars of the College of the Holy and Undivided Trinity in the University of Oxford.

Coming into operation of this Scheme

8. This Scheme shall come into operation upon the first day of the month following the date of it being made by the Church Commissioners.

SCHEDULE TO THE SCHEME

- 1. All that detached part of the parish of Newbold de Verdun which is stippled and labelled "Newbold de Verdun det. 1" and all that part of the parish of Newbold de Verdun which is stippled and lettered "C" on the annexed map A shall be transferred to the parish of Barlestone.
- 2. All that detached part of the parish of Market Bosworth, Cadeby with Sutton Cheney and Congerstone which is stippled and labelled "Market Bosworth, Cadeby with Sutton Cheney and Congerstone det. 01" on the annexed map A shall be transferred to the parish of Nailstone.
- 3. All that part of the parish of Barlestone which is stippled and lettered "A" on the annexed map A shall be transferred to the parish of Nailstone.
- 4. All that part of the parish of Newbold de Verdun which is stippled and lettered "B" on the annexed map A shall be transferred to the parish of Market Bosworth, Cadeby with Sutton Cheney and Congerstone.
- 5. All that part of the parish of Kirkby Mallory which is stippled and lettered "D" on the annexed map B shall be transferred to the parish of Newbold de Verdun.
- 6. All that part of the parish of Thornton, Bagworth and Stanton under Bardon which is stippled and lettered "E" on the annexed map B shall be transferred to the parish of Newbold de Verdun.

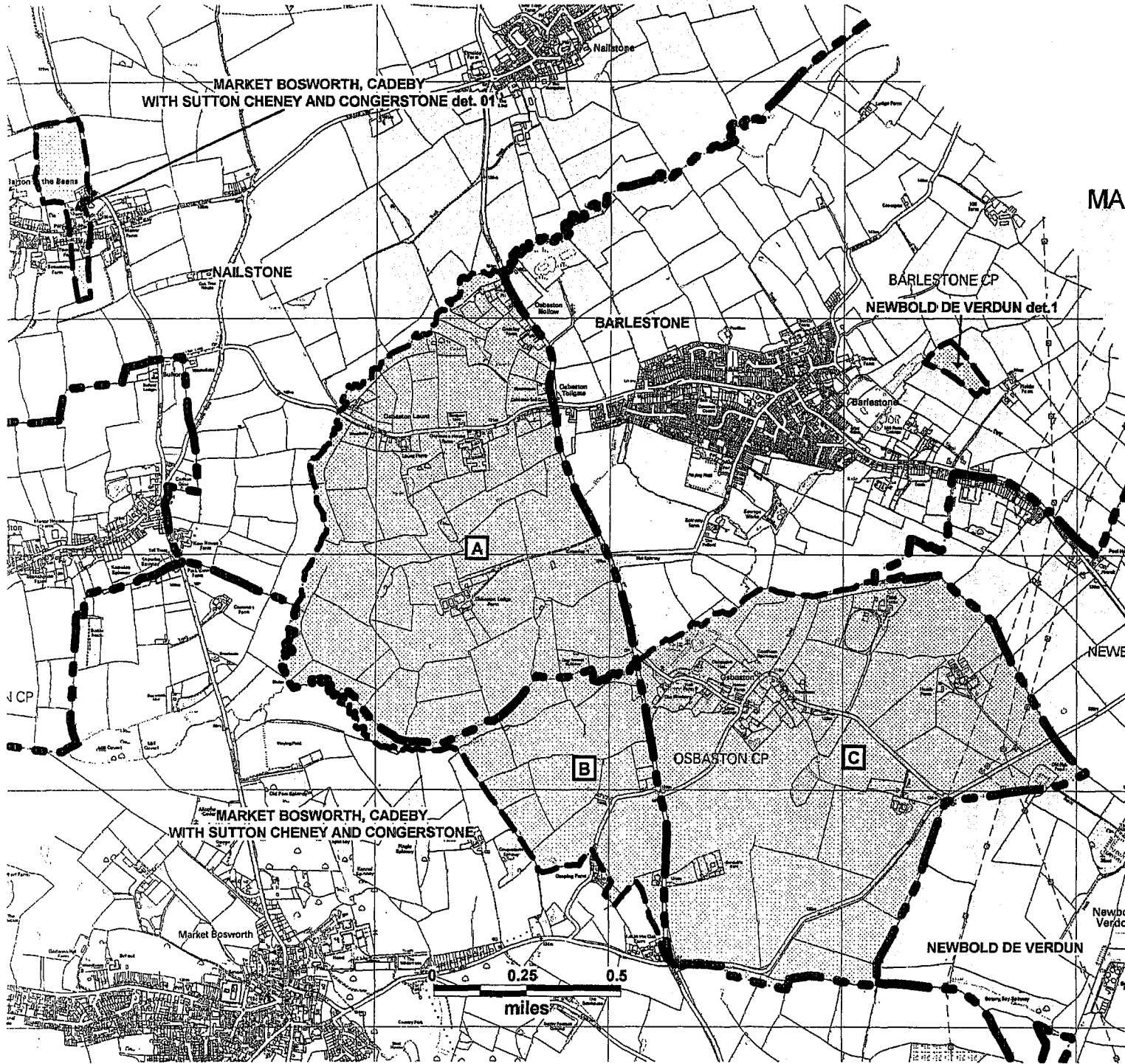

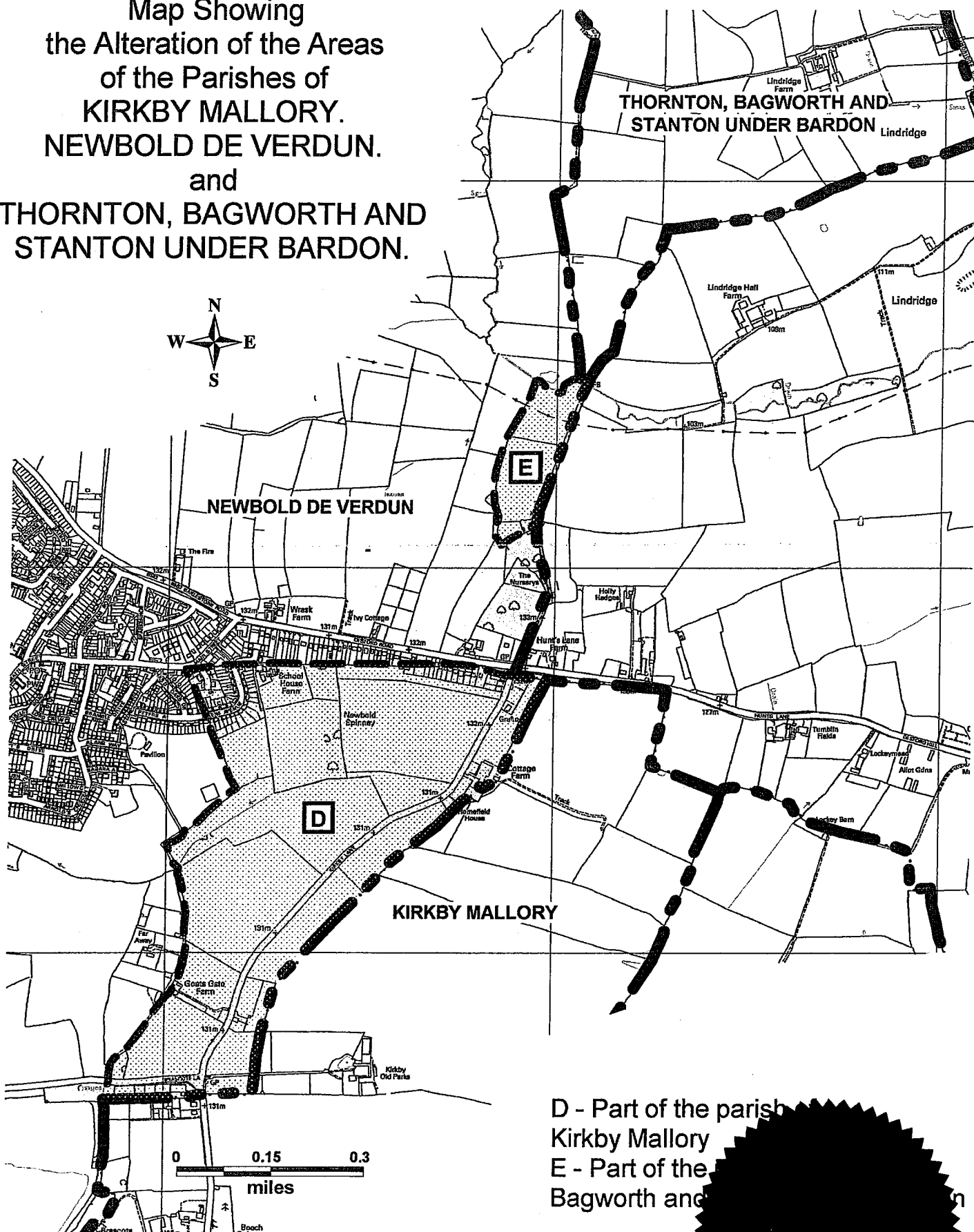
Map Showing
